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A Tuffet Making Workshop In Two Sessions

In two (3 hour) sessions you will create your own unique Tuffet! In Session 1 you will be sewing and learn the technique to make the foundation pieced Tuffet cover. Between sessions at home you will finish the sewing portion of the class. During Session 2 we will put the Tuffet together. Tuffets can be whimsical, elegant, scrappy, or made to match any room. Every kid needs a Tuffet, even grown up ones!

Tuffet Making Workshop in Two Sessions

REQUIRED PATTERN: Pieced 18" Tuffet by Tuffet Source.

The instructor, will supply tools needed for assembly.

REQUIRED KIT: Tuffet Finishing Kit. Kit includes pre-drilled wood base, 18" round upholstery foam (with a 50lb ILD), Dacron upholstery batting, t-nuts, cording and button, 4 Bun feet – with 5/16" -18 hanger bolt already installed. Available from Holly Dee Quilts or Tuffet Source.

PRE-CLASS HOMEWORK (mandatory): To maximize time in class come prepared for Session 1 as follows:

PRECUT: 32 (3"x21") fabric strips and arrange in your design order.

For example:

- If you are using 8 fabrics, you will have 8 stacks with 4 strips in each stack.
- If you are using 4 fabrics, you will have 4 stacks with 8 strips in each stack.
- If you are using a whole focal fabric in every other panel, you will have 1 stack of your focal fabric, and 4 stacks of 4 strips in each stack.

Minimum enrollment = 4. Class may be cancelled (with refund) if minimum enrollment is not met.

Session 1 Supply List

Bring to Session 1

- □ KIT which contains instructions and pre-printed muslin
 □ 18" square or a fat quarter for bottom of tuffet
 □ 6" square of coordinating fabric for button
 □ Cover fabric: 8 FQ or 8 1/4 yd cuts
- ☐ Sewing Machine in good working order
- ☐ Thread that coordinate with your fabric
- 3 Bobbins wound with the same thread
- ☐ Straight Pins
- ☐ Rotary Cutter with **NEW** blade
- ☐ 18" or 24" Rotary Cutting Ruler
- ☐ Basic sewing supplies including seam ripper
- Optional but Recommended: 12" add-a-quarter-ruler and presser foot that lets you see the seam you are sewing

DO NOT USE UPHOLSTERY FABRIC

NOTE: If you choose a jelly roll, homework will take you up to 8 hours outside of class! You will have a LOT more sewing to do with a jelly roll.

Homework Before DO THIS BEFORE Session 1

PRECUT: 32 (3x21) strips of fabric and arrange in your design order

Examples: If you are using 8 fabrics, you will have 8 stacks with 4 strips in each stack. If you are using 4 fabrics, you will have 4 stacks with 8 strips in each stack. If you are using a whole focal fabric in every other panel, you will have 1 stack of your focal fabric, and 4 stacks of 4 strips in each stack.

Take a photo or number your fabrics, so you can keep track of the arrangement you have decided upon.

Make sure your sewing machine works!

Session 2 Supply List

Bring to Session 2

TUFFET KIT WITH 4 BUN FEET available for purchase as signup of class, may be some available at session 1
Finished Tuffet Cover and Covered Button
Bottom Fabric
Rotary Cutter with sharp blade
BOTH large AND small sharp fabric scissors
Small ruler and sharpie to mark foam for optional beveled top
Straight Pins
12 " circle of batting for bottom (optional but makes for a nice finish)
Optional: Upholstery tacks found at a hardware store, online or JoAnns
Optional: Matching thread to whipstitch bottom fabric

Instructor provides: pneumatic staple gun, safety glasses, hammers, marking tools, long upholstery needles and various other tools and necessary. NO **MACHINES!**

Homework Before

DO THIS BEFORE Session 2

PRESEW: Sew all fabric onto the muslin foundation. Sew all completed panels together per instruction. (Optional) Cover the button using upholstery thread or dental floss, you'll also need a wide eye needle. DO NOT USE SEWING THREAD FOR THE BUTTON Note: Tuffet Kit will include: (Here is a checklist for you to verify you have all parts) ☐ 18" Round Upholstery Foam ☐ 17" plywood predrilled for button finishing and with preinstalled T-nuts

4 Yards of Cord for tufting and drawstring

☐ 36" x 36" Dacron Upholstery Batting

☐ 4 Bun Feet

Required Pattern - Tuffet Source pattern with interfacing from Holly Dee Quilting

*Kelly, the instructor, will supply finishing kits and tools needed to finish.



Required Finishing Kit - Tuffet Source Tuffet Kit either normal or mini size including pre-drilled base, pre-cut foam, Dacron batting, t-nuts, cording, button and bun feet (with pre installed bolt)



Required Fabric and Supplies - list provided upon payment for workshop.

Note: upholstery supplies and tools are not required.



Homework prepared before each session - class will not wait for you to catch-up (it's not fair to everyone else). List provided upon payment for workshop.
